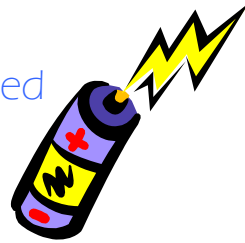




## NEW! Permanent Battery Recycling Program
